- B. Football scoreboard - New scoreboard is installed, we paid \$1000 for the scoreboard itself and the laptop to run it. It was bought used from Council Bluffs. It had become very difficult to replace the bulbs in the old scoreboard. - C. State Softball expenses - Just giving the Booster Club a heads up that the hotel will cost around \$4000 and per diem will be around \$1600 for the 24 players/student managers. Josh just wanted to share so we are aware of the expenses.
