 - Mr. Andrew Bradley (Began July 1, 2024)

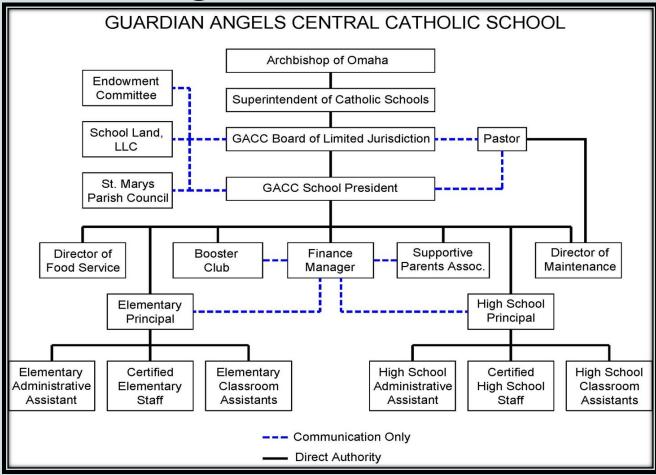
GACC School Board = Board of Limited Jurisdiction

GACC School Budget Overview

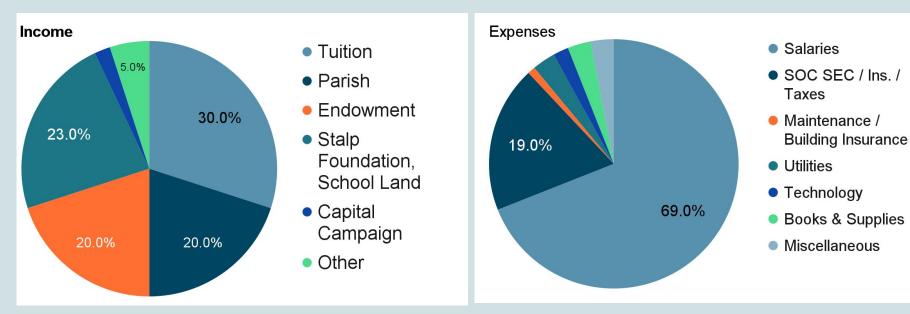
