CREATING A FEDERAL STUDENT AID ACCOUNT (FSA ID)

Before completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), the student and at least one parent will need to create Federal Student Aid (FSA) accounts. (If parents are divorced, separated, or remarried the parent providing the most financial support is the appropriate parent. If support is equal, the parent with the greater income is used.)

- Student and parent will each need their own account.
- Allow up to 3-days for verification processing before starting the FAFSA

Follow these steps:

- 1. Go to studentaid.gov and click on Create Account
- 2. Enter personal information.
 - · Name, date of birth, Social Security number
 - Email address, mailing address, mobile phone number
 - Both student and parent need separate email addresses
 - Students should not use high school email account
- Answer "challenge" questions. Select answers that are easy to remember and won't change over time
- 4. Enter validation code to confirm both your mobile phone number and email address
- 5. Save your information.
 - Write down your FSA ID username and password
 - Use the same username and password throughout our college experience
